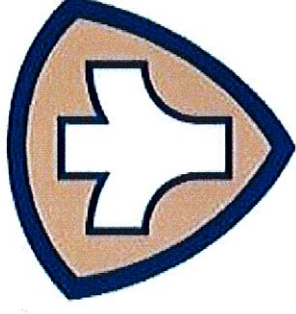


# Updated COVID-19 Guidelines

as of December 27, 2021



## Public Health

### **IF YOU TEST POSITIVE OR HAVE SYMPTOMS**

*Everyone, regardless of vaccine status.*

- Stay home for 5 days (day 0 is date of test or symptom onset).
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you may leave your house.
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves without fever reducing medication.

### **IF YOU WERE EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID:**

*If you have received your booster*

**OR**  
*completed the primary series (2-doses) of Pfizer or Moderna in the last 6 months* **OR**  
*completed the primary series of J&J in the last 2 months.*

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.
- If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home.

### **IF YOU WERE EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID:**

*If you are unvaccinated* **OR**  
*completed the primary series (2-doses) of Pfizer or Moderna* **OR**  
*6 months ago* **OR**  
*completed the primary series of J&J* **OVER 2 months ago.**

- Stay home for 5 days.  
After that wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.
- If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home.
- If you can't quarantine, you must wear a mask for 10 days.
